

The bugliest bug

This session is designed for the foundation stage and aims to introduce your students to outdoor exploration and the world of invertebrates.

Through the interactive story-telling of the 'Bugliest Bug', children get to meet some of the mini-beasts that live on Hampstead Heath and learn about their habits.

Followed by a hands-on bug-hunting activity and/or pond-dipping in one of our enclosed gardens, the children also explore the places these creatures live and how they look, how they move and even how they feel!

The session also contains educational games and role-play and can be complemented with an art activity (making your own damselfly!).

Book your session for the Spring and Summer months when the wildlife is easier to spot.
