Hampstead Heath is a great place for children to enjoy the outdoors. With impressive play facilities spread across the Heath, we are sure that there is something for children of all ages to enjoy.

Parliament Hill Fields Playground

This playground is for children up to the age of 12 and has challenging structures for all abilities. It encourages controlled risks in a safe environment. There are climbing walls, multilevel multiplay structures, swings (including cradle swing with seats for children with mobility disabilities), slides, tactile play units and a wheelchair accessible sand pit.

The site is fully staffed by trained first aiders every day between April and October and every weekend throughout the year.

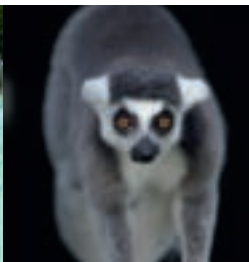
While on site parents and carers remain responsible for their children at all times.
